India Power Empowers Women Through GDA Program Under CSR Initiative

India Power takes immense pride in empowering the women of Asansol through the General Duty Assistant (GDA) Program, a key initiative under our CSR activities for the Financial Year 2024–25. This program marked our first collaboration with the Mukesh Himatsingka Foundation (MHF), an NGO committed to community development. Hosted at our SPS Centre, where we dedicated one of our quarters to provide them with infrastructural benefits in the learning process, the program successfully trained 30 women from the Jamuria District of ASANSOL, a prime business hub of India Power. We not only provided them with theoretical knowledge but also hands-on, on-the-job training.

This initiative offered extensive practical experience, giving the participants exposure to real-world healthcare environments and helping them gain confidence and independence. As part of the program, the trainees were sent for on-the-job training to leading metropolitan cities across India.

With the support of MHF, we were able to secure placements for 22 out of the 30 women at renowned hospitals such as CMRI Kolkata, Apollo Genesis Kolkata, and SVK Hospital Bangalore.
